1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Keppel Coast Dirt Bike Club Inc. hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct Club Days for Motocross at Coastal Park, Yeppon, on eight (8) Sundays in 2017 :- February 19; March 19; April 09; May 7; June 17; July 2; August 6; October 15.

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The above-mentioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Queensland who have issued the Motorcycling Australia Permits and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National, Mini and One Meeting Licences (OML to Junior riders only if they hold a current JCP Log Book) who are full financial members of the Keppel Coast DBC. (No one day membership allowed)
 - 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by Motorcycling Queensland
- BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.**

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and close day of racing.
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Club, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling Queensland.
- 3.3. Only entries received on the official Entry Form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.4. **NOTE:- RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CLUB.**

4. INSURANCE:

- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.3. ***IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.***

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

QAS or Professional 1st Aid Services with facilities as per current GCR's from the start of practice till 15 minutes after the last event.

6 ENTRY FEE:

- 6.1. \$30.00 Junior - \$30.00 Senior. 50cc Demo Class \$15
- 6.2. Payment by Cash, Eftpos or Cheque ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURED CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.
- 6.3. Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to Keppel Coast Dirt Bike Club Inc.

7 CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

- 50cc Demo: 4 – Under 9 years (demonstration Class)
- 50cc Auto: 7 – under 9 years
- 65cc: 7-under 10 years
- 65cc: 10 – under 12 years
- Mini Lites 9 – under 12 years: SW 85cc 2/- & 150cc 4/- (*Competition Model Only*)
- Mini Lites 12 – under 16 years: SW & BW 85cc 2/- & 150cc 4/- (*Competition Model Only*)
- Junior Lites: 13 – under 16 years: 100cc to 150cc 2/- & 200cc to 250cc 4/
- Senior Lites: Up to 250cc 2/- & 250cc 4/-
- Senior Unlimited Class: 251cc 2T and over – 251cc 4T and over
- Clubman Lites: Up to 250cc 2T- & 250cc 4T-
- Clubman Open: 251cc 2T and over – 251cc 4T and over
- Masters: Age 33 and older (Open to all capacity bikes)
- Ladies: Riders over 16 – (may race with another senior class, dependant of numbers to constitute a class)

Note: Clubman Riders are C grade riders only-at the discretion of the Clerk of Course riders may be placed in the Senior Lites or Unlimited Class.

- 7.2 The two age group classes of 65cc and the two age group classes of 85cc may be combined at the discretion of the Clerk of Course, making one race for the 65cc riders and one race for the 85cc riders per round of racing.
- 7.3 A Junior rider's age on January 1 will determine his/her age for competition that year. However, a rider may move to the next higher class when he/she becomes eligible to do so at any time during the year, but once a rider moves to the higher age class in any competition, he/she may not move back to the lower age class. Points earned in a lower class will not transfer to the higher class. This rule will apply to all riders up to and including 16 year olds.

8 AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

9 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 9.1 To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be 5 nominations.
- 9.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prize money, will be at the discretion of the club, subject to Motorcycling Queensland approval.

10 RACE FORMAT:

Unless stated otherwise at Riders Briefing, all classes shall have three rounds of racing, points from all club days in 2017 will accrue. The rider with the highest points score in each class at the end of the year shall be declared club champion of that class.

11 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 11.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Motocross Competition.
- 11.2. Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.
- 11.3. Helmets are mandatory. All persons including officials using any bike, trike or quad at an event must be wearing a properly secured helmet.

GOPRO and other cameras are prohibited to be worn on helmets. Helmets must be free of cameras and mounting systems as per latest MA rule changes.

Tear offs are not able to be used from 1st January,2017. Roll offs are permitted and should be used.

12 RIDING NUMBERS:

- 12.1. Competitors will be allocated their Registered Riding Number. This is the number on the back of your competition licence. It is the riders responsibility to ensure there riding numbers are clearly visible to allow for correct lap scoring. Numbers, font and background should comply with GCR requirements. Back numbers should be worn to assist with lap scoring as per GCR requirements.

- 12.2. All Number Plates on all Machines MUST comply with the GCR's.

13 GRID POSITIONS:

If numbers indicate gate draw by peg otherwise competitors choose.

14 RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing. ALL Competitors MUST attend the Riders Briefing. Riders Briefing is a NON Smoking Area.

15 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 15.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 15.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at Motorcycling Queensland's discretion until the results of the tests are known.

16 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

17 TIMETABLE:

Nominations at 7.30am, Machinery at 7.45am, Riders Briefing at 8.15, Practice at 8.30am, Racing commences at completion of practice.
For the purposes of drug & alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 7.30am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.
A time will be made available during Scrutineering for the riders to inspect the track by foot.

18 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

Track is mid packed dirt with man-made jumps and is 1.1 kilometres long.

19 STARTS:

36 Self penalising backward falling gates.

20 RACING:

Practice is	4 laps or 10 minutes per class whichever is the lesser
50cc	10 minutes +1 lap
65cc	4 laps
Mini Lites	5 laps
Junior Lites	7 laps
Senior Lites / Unlimited	7 laps
Clubman Lites	5 laps
Clubman Open	5 laps
Masters / Ladies	5 laps

Laps can be changed at Officials discretion on the day with approval from the MQ Steward
The maximum number of riders in practice will be 125% of the number of start gates.

21. NOISE:

Noise testing during the event as per GCR's

22. GST:

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prize money over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

23. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 23.1 Riding motorbikes *or push bikes* in the pits is not allowed;
- 24.2 No dogs permitted, guide dogs excepted;
- 24.3 Presentation shall be conducted at the completion of racing.

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

2. DEFINITIONS

- a) "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- b) "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- c) "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- d) "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
- e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- a) motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
 - i) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - ii) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
 - iii) that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
 - iv) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
 - vi) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
 - vii) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - viii) that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
- b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- c) to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- d) have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:

- rendered with due care and skill;
 - as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
 - reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.
- Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

5. INDEMNITY AND RELEASE GIVEN TO ORGANISERS

IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of me as a participant in the Meeting:

- a) I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them in the following manner:
 - i) that I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
 - ii) that I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;
 - iii) that I indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnitees, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions, costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.
- b) I AGREE TO RELEASE to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them from all liability to me for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, psychological trauma, death, property damage or infringement of third party rights or otherwise) that arises as a result of any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by me or which is in any way connected with my presence at or involvement in the Event.

- d) A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

6. MEDICAL

I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Meeting. I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept the Indemnitees will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.
I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

7. PRIVACY

I hereby consent to the collection of my personal information by the Promoter/Event Organiser, MA and the SCB in connection with my involvement at the Event and the use and disclosure of my personal information by Event Organiser, and MA to other agencies and officials associated with the Event for the purposes of conducting and managing the Event. I understand that I may gain access to my personal information held by contacting MA at 147 Montague St, South Melbourne, Victoria, 3205. I understand that if I do not provide the personal information requested above that I may not be permitted to participate in the Event.

8. PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION

I hereby agree with MA and the SCB that in consideration for my participation in the Event that MA and the SCB may receive, collect, store and use personal health information about me in the manner set out below:

- a) I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
 - i) If I am injured, become ill or die at or following the Event the party listed at item 8 in Schedule 1 in addition to any hospital at which I am treated (together "my Carers") will have health related information about me in their possession, power and control relating to me which is subject to obligations imposed by the Privacy Act ("my Information") and the Privacy Act is intended to protect my personal information;
 - ii) MA and my SCB wish to collect my Information for purposes that include their risk management programs, evaluating and improving the safety of MA and SCB events and of the Meeting organisers and facility providers of MA / SCB permitted events, and generally to reduce the risks to persons engaged in motorcycle sport; and

iii) It is reasonable for MA and my SCB to collect, store, use and disclose my Information in accordance with clause 11(a)(i) above and in the manner set out in clause 11(b).

b) IN CONSIDERATION of my acceptance as an entrant in the Meeting I consent and agree that MA and my SCB:

- i) may collect and store any of my Information, including obtain my Information from third parties including my Carers;

- c) I irrevocably authorise MA and my SCB and hereby appoint MA and my SCB as my lawful attorneys to collect from my Carers, and I hereby direct my Carers to provide to MA or my SCB upon request being made by MA or my SCB, any of my Information including but not limited to any information concerning any incident or event causing or contributing to or resulting from any injury, illness or death to me, the details of any diagnosis and prognosis provided to me by my Carers (or any party with the knowledge of any of my Carers), and any other matter to the knowledge of my Carers that might reasonably be considered to be requested by MA or my SCB for the purpose of improving safety at MA and SCB events.

9. POLICIES AND REGULATIONS
